◆ In order to request for thesis evaluation, students **MUST pass** the Qualification Exam: **General Exam**.

◆ You have **3 chances in total** to take the General Exam.

1) Requirements for the General Exam

- ① Must be completed in your 3rd Semester or later within 10 years of admission.
- ② At least 27 credits completed by the end of the 3rd Semester.
- ③ Accumulative average GPA of 3.0 or higher
- ④ Completed all CORE Courses.

* If you do not meet any of requirements above, you are not be eligible to take the General Exam and submit your thesis until you meet all requirements above. You will automatically be extending to an extra semester.

◆ In order to request for thesis evaluation, students **MUST** pass or be exempted from the Qualification Exam: **Language (English & 2nd Foreign Language) Exams.**

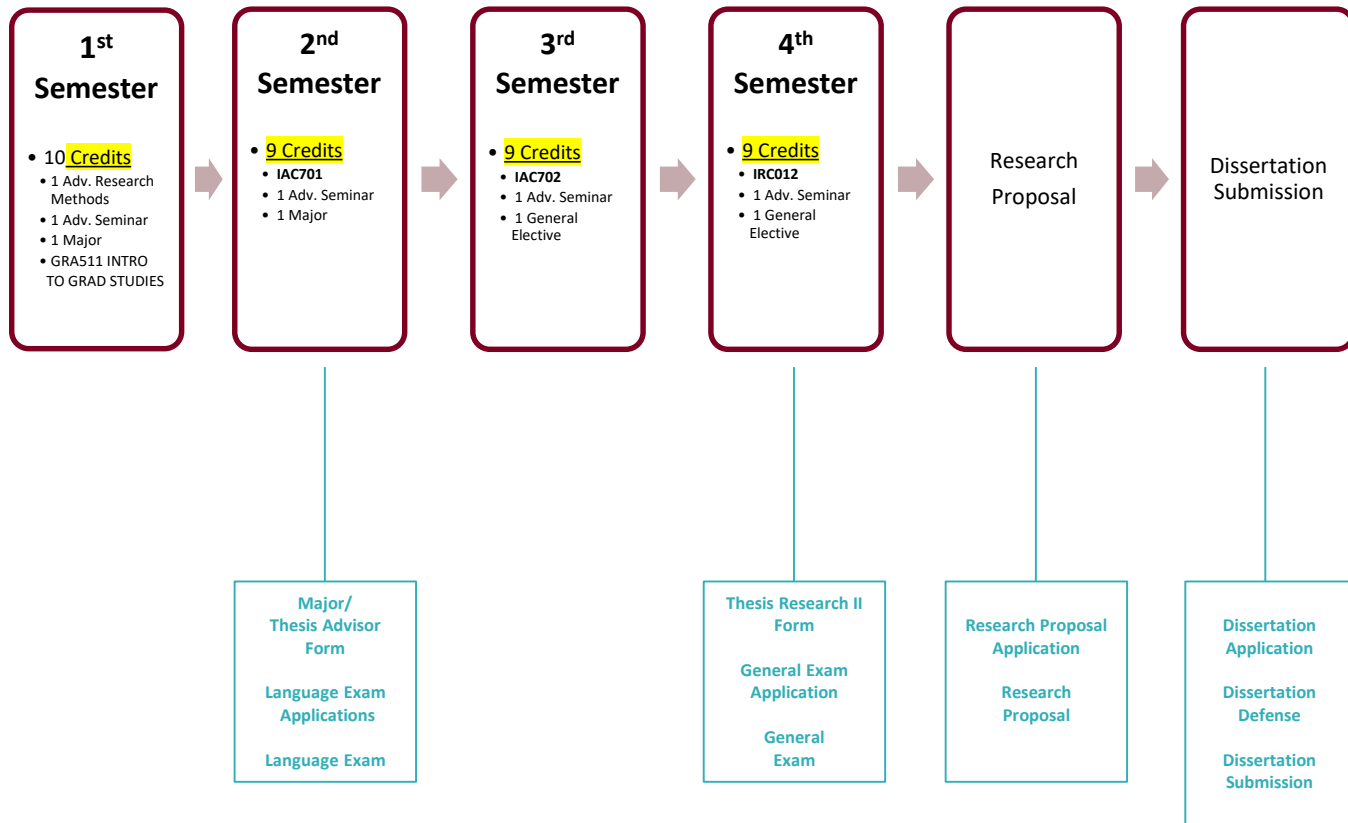
1) Exemption conditions from English Exam

- ① TOEFL score 237 (CBT) or above *within* 2 years
- ② MA degree abroad (or GSIS in Korea) that all courses were conducted in English
 - Take KU IFLS (Institute of Foreign Language Studies) Courses for Graduate School English Credit and earn a grade over B.
 - Take KU English Exam for Graduation held by KU IFLS.
- ※ Or will have to take and pass the KU English Exam held by KU IFLS.

2) Exemption conditions from 2nd Foreign Language Exam

- ① Authorized transcript standards for foreign language examination waiver
- ② Take KU IFLS or KLC (Korean Language Center) Courses for Graduate School 2nd Foreign Language Credit and earn a grade over B.
- ③ If you received your BA or MA degree abroad, the language of the country that you earn your degree from will be accepted as your 2nd Foreign Language.
 - * For International Students: Native language cannot meet the 2nd Foreign Language requirement, but you can choose 'Korean' or other languages as 2nd Foreign Language.
- ※ Or will have to take and pass the KU 2nd Foreign Language Exam held by KU General Graduate School.

◆ Doctoral Courses (Advanced Seminars) of KU GSIS – for Master's

- o Accepted as General Elective (Some courses can be transferred to Major courses)
- o Requirements: Enrolled for 3rd or later Semester & Accumulative GPA of 4.0 or above OR Professor's approval
- o Consult with KU GSIS Administration Office prior to the course registration.

◆ Courses from KU General Graduate School (ONLY ENGLISH COURSES)

- o Courses conducted in ENGLISH from General Graduate School will be accepted as General Elective.
- o Consult with KU GSIS Administration Office prior to the course registration.

◆ Other GSIS in Korea (ONLY ENGLISH COURSES)

- o Courses conducted in ENGLISH from other GSIS in Korea will be accepted as General Elective.
(1) Seoul National University, (2) Yonsei University, (3) Ewha Woman's University, (4) Kyung Hee University (Suwon Campus),
(5) Sogang University, (6) Chung-ang University, (7) Hankuk University of Foreign Studies, (8) Hanyang University
