



1. AI in Economic Enhancement and High-Quality Development

In this scenario, we invite young people worldwide to brainstorm and ponder deeply on harnessing AI's economic benefits while mitigating its challenges, thus fostering high-quality and sustainable AI-enhanced economic development.

2. AI in Political Construction and Efficient Governance

Political construction is fundamental to future prosperity. The rapid deployment of AI technology significantly impacts the political arena, transforming international governance, political decision-making, governance models, government services, and citizen participation. AI's facilitation of smarter global governance strategies and political decision-making, alongside innovations in governance models and enhancements in government service efficiency and quality, mark a significant shift. However, AI also poses substantial challenges to national governance, including the standardization of AI development and the protection of privacy and equity.

We encourage young minds globally to deliberate on leveraging AI's political advantages to foster

domestic and global governance, and on preventing potential ethical risks to ensure AI applications align with social values and legal standards, promoting a collaborative and shared approach to AI governance.

3. AI in Enhancing Social Life and Quality of Life

A harmonious society lays the groundwork for future development. AI technology, manifesting in daily life through SMART+ innovations, reshapes social systems and introduces new concepts like SMART+ Household Appliances, SMART+ Education, SMART+ Medical Services, and SMART+ Travel. However, the SMART+ paradigm also encounters risks such as deepfakes and misinformation, with overreliance on AI systems potentially diminishing basic human skills.

We call upon the youth worldwide to explore the harmonious coexistence of humans and AI, aiming to improve humanity's collective well-being while ensuring social security and respect for human rights. Deep exploration into regulating AI in social spheres, maximizing its benefits, and mitigating risks is crucial for fostering a healthy, orderly, and high-quality life in an intelligent society.

4.AI in Cultural Development and Civilized Prosperity

Culture is the essence of future development. AI technology's potential in the cultural sector is undeniable, supporting cultural industry innovation, enriching cultural experiences and products, and enhancing global cultural heritage protection. Nevertheless, employing AI in culture raises issues around intellectual property rights, cultural heritage, and the risks of artistic innovation. Inappropriate handling could adversely affect cultural development.

We motivate young individuals globally to reflect on optimizing AI's cultural benefits and addressing its challenges, thus contributing to cultural prosperity.

5. AI in Eco-Governance and Promoting Harmonious Coexistence between Humans and Nature

The foundation of sustainable development is ecological civilization construction. AI technology's evolution is revolutionizing natural resource management and ecological protection, paving new paths for ecological civilization advancement. Innovations in AI, such as machine learning, biometric identification, computer vision, knowledge mapping, and more, are becoming integral to ecological protection, restoration, early warning, management, and other facets of ecological construction. Through sophisticated data analysis, pattern recognition, and predictive capabilities, AI significantly contributes to biodiversity conservation, climate change response, environmental monitoring and governance, natural resource management, and the advancement of ecological research and education.

In this emerging epoch, we encourage young people worldwide to harness the immense power of AI in ecological construction, collaboratively working towards a green and sustainable future. It's a collective effort to protect our fragile and beautiful planet, ensuring a harmonious coexistence between humans and nature.

Arrangement in the Final Round

The YICGG2024 Committee will randomly divide all the contestants into World Teams. World Teams need to carry out research on the final theme of YICGG2024 which will be announced at the opening ceremony, and each team should submit a written project within the limited time and deliver a presentation.

During the Final Round, contestants will participate in a series of activities centered around the final theme, including:

1. Ice Breaking:

The Ice Breaking session is designed to gently facilitate communication and acquaintance among contestants. Through a series of engaging and interactive activities, including games and collaborative challenges, we aim to foster a warm and inviting atmosphere where barriers naturally dissolve. This welcoming environment encourages contestants to connect and share, setting the stage for a fruitful and enjoyable experience.

2. Ignite Talk

It is an optional part for the contestants. Applicants are required to submit their Talk outlines (150-200 words) focused on their chosen topics. Around 20 applicants will be selected by the judges to share their

insights in the Ignite Talk. The most impressive participant will be honored with the individual award "The Ignite Talk King/Queen (ITK/ITQ)".

3. World Café

It is a form of brainstorming. The World Teams engage in round-table discussions under the guidance of judges, focusing on their proposals developed according to the final theme. Each discussion lasts 15-20 minutes. When the time is up, the World Teams rotate to the next table, where another judge leads the discussion, and so on, allowing contestants to interact with all the judges. The judges and contestants continuously exchange their ideas, igniting sparks of thought.

4. We Youth Common Agenda (WYCA)

"We Youth Common Agenda" aims to nourish the common goals of the youth who share a passion for global governance. The committee will prepare a draft of the WYCA according to preliminary proposals. During the final round, we will conduct a round of idea collection from the World Teams through roundtable discussions. The final version of the WYCA will then be completed, drawing on the outcomes of these discussions, and will be announced at the Closing Ceremony.

5. Field Work

"Field Work" offers contestants a unique opportunity to engage in onsite research, immersing themselves in locales imbued with distinctive local characteristics. It is recommended to document the Field Work through the use of photos, videos, or audio recordings, capturing the essence of the experience firsthand and deepening your understanding of local conditions and traditions. These records serve as invaluable resources for the final presentation.

6. Culture Night

Culture Night serves as a platform for contestants to engage in cross-cultural interaction. During this event, participants can showcase their preferred modes of expression, such as singing, dancing or speaking. Contestants hailing from diverse regions and countries converge to enhance their comprehension and communication through varied forms of performance and interaction.

7. Final Presentation

The session provides the contestants with the opportunity to showcase their achievements. Each World Team is required to select a minimum of 2 representatives to deliver a 10-minute PowerPoint presentation, allowing 7 minutes for presentation and 3 minutes for Q&A. Multimedia methods are encouraged. Following the presentations and proposals, judges will evaluate and score each team's performance. The team achieving the highest score will be recognized with the "Most Valuable Project (MVP)".

Attachment 5 Subsidy

In order to encourage more participants to join YICGG and continuously pay attention to global governance, qualified YICGG2024 participants can apply for the subsidies listed below:

1. Continuity

For consecutive participation, a subsidy of 200 RMB is available.

2. Diversity

Participants from historically underrepresented countries in YICGG can apply for a subsidy as follows:

- 600 RMB for Africa, Latin America, Oceania, and the Nordic region;
- 400 RMB for Eastern Europe and South and Central Asia;
- 200 RMB for North America, East Asia, and other parts of Europe.

3. Variety

Teams comprising members from multiple countries can apply for a subsidy of:

- 600 RMB per person for teams consisting of members from 3 or more countries;
- 400 RMB per person for teams consisting of members from 2 countries.

4. Publicity

Participants promoting YICGG in their educational institutions or home countries can apply for the following subsidies:

- 500 RMB for returning participants who introduce new participants to YICGG2024;
- 200 RMB for new participants introduced by previous participants;
- 200 RMB for obtaining 200 or more social media likes on YICGG-related content;
- 100 RMB for achieving 100 likes.
