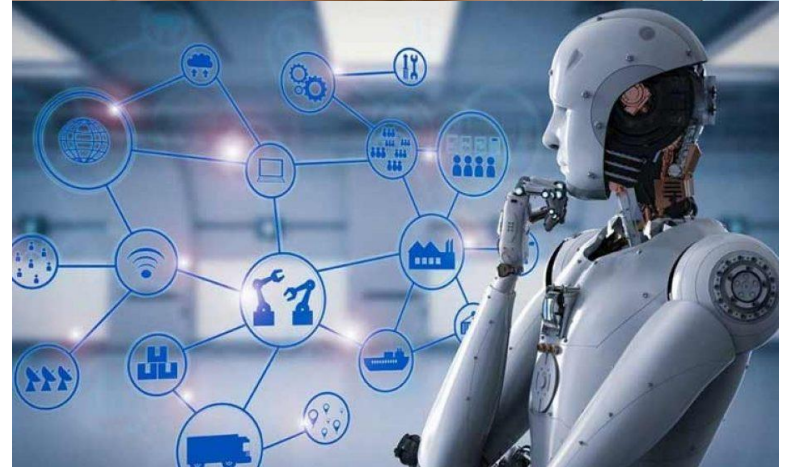
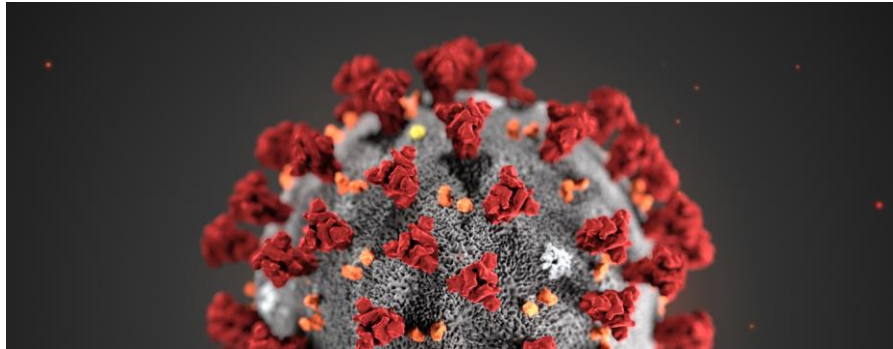


- **Why international studies?**

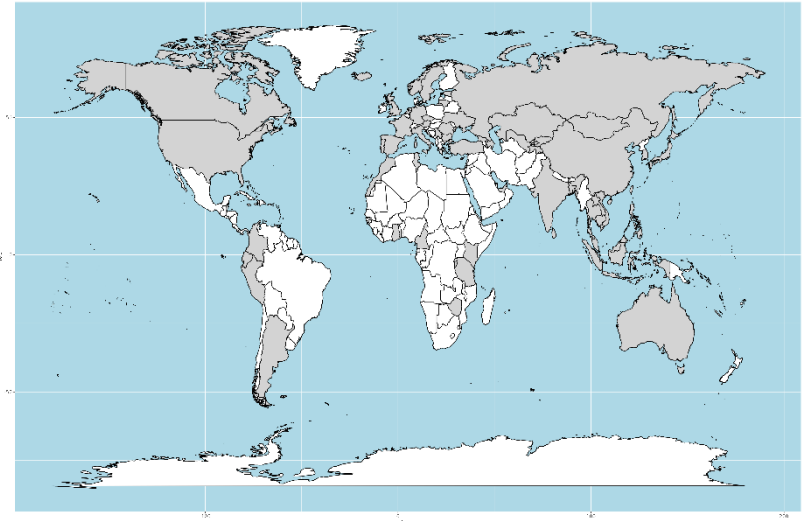

지난 5년 간 유럽 정치와 경제는 수많은 도전을 겪어 왔다. 아직 불씨가 남은 유로존 재정 위기, '아랍의 봄'에 따른 난민의 대거 유입, 이런 혼란을 틈타 세력을 확장한 극우세력의 발호 등의 문제를 슬기롭게 해결하는 게 지난 60여 년 동안 유럽이 이룬 지역통합의 성과를 장기적으로 유지하는 데 중요한 정책과제가 됐다. 그런데 이런 과제를 둘러싸고 최근 유럽에서 나타난 포퓰리즘의 기세가 심상찮아, 유럽의 미래를 위협하고 있다.

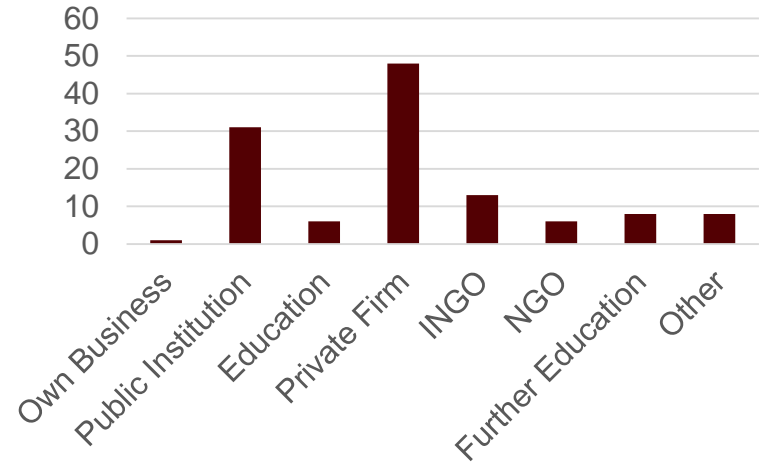

- Your SOP is the most important document.



- Request documents and recommendation letter as soon as possible.
- Your SOP is the most important document:
 - Don't tell us you are diligent and hardworking. We know.
 - Don't simply summarize content elsewhere in your application.
 - Do explain what makes you unique. Tell us your story.
 - Do be clear about what you want to learn.
 - Do explain your motivations for studying your topic of interest.

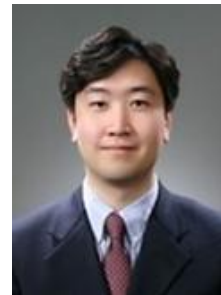

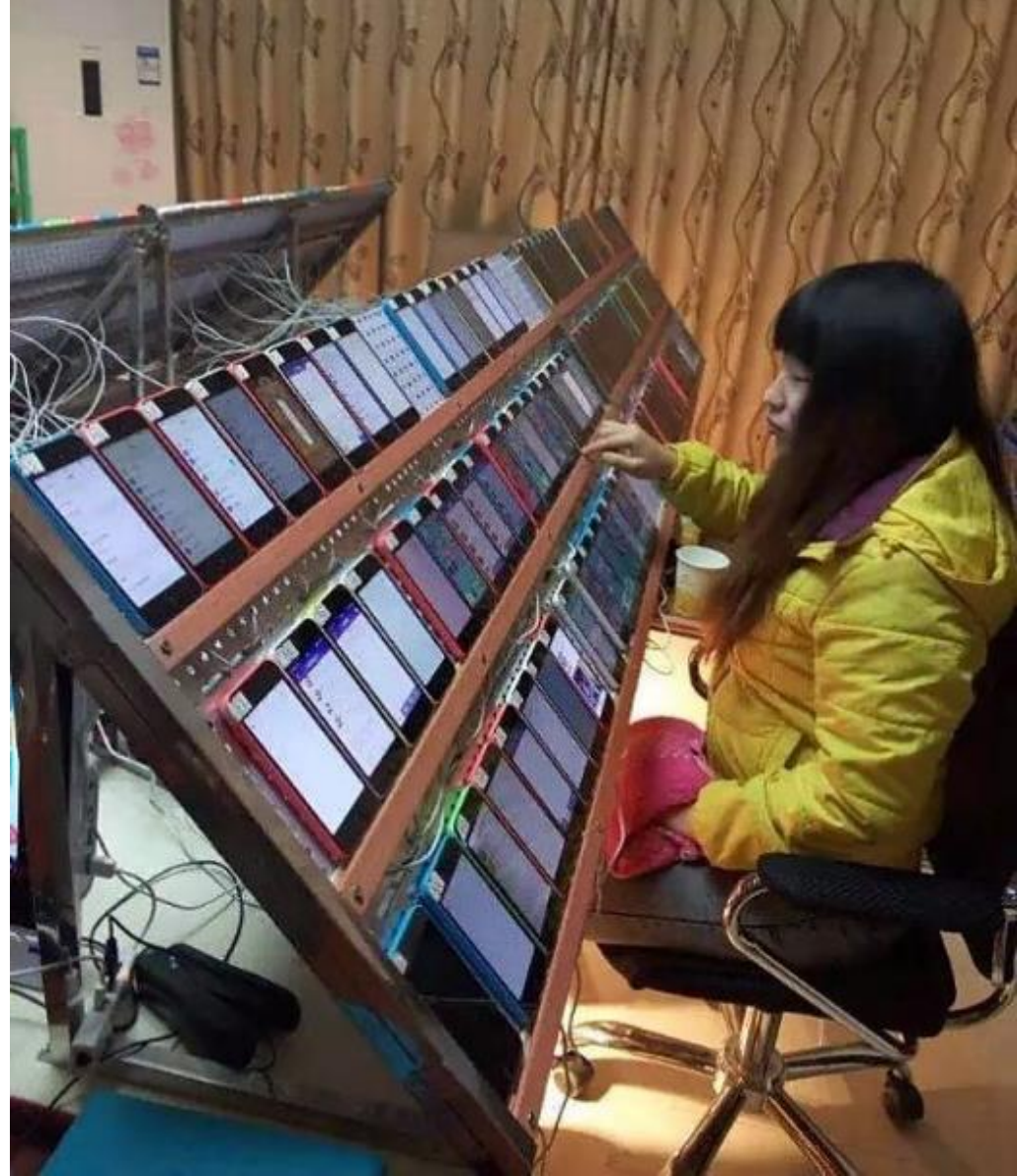
